d) Where has your container come from (the Port of Origin)? _____


e) Using the 'Shipping Map', locate the Port of Origin. Which shipping service has brought your container to London Gateway? _____

Task 2: Collect your container

As the truck driver you must now collect your container from DP World London Gateway Port. Follow the correct process and obey health and safety regulations. All drivers collecting a container are required to go through every stage in the right order, following the strict instructions of DP World London Gateway Port.

Follow the 'Container Collection Procedure' using the slides of the same name.

2a) Insert the correct action for each stage into the box on your Terminal Map (on the previous page of this document), choosing from these 8 phrases:

Receive printed ticket

Swipe ID card for entry

Reverse and follow instructions

Wait to see your vehicle registration

Check numbers

Swipe ID card for exit

Drive slowly at max 13mph

Proceed slowly

2b) Answer the question below about each stage as you progress.

STAGE IN PROCESS	QUESTION	YOUR ANSWER
(1) OPTICAL CHARACTER RECOGNITION	What is the permitted maximum height and width of a truck?	
(2) PRE GATE IN	When the driver swipes their ID card, what is the computer checking?	
(3) MAIN GATE IN	What does this check tell the driver?	
(5) CALL FORWARD ZONE	What must the driver NOT do?	
(7&8) LANDSIDE TRANSFER ZONES	What must the driver remember to do?	
MODULES	Who is never allowed here?	
(9) OCR PORTAL & RADIATION SCANNER	Why is it so important to drive slowly here?	
(10) PRE GATE OUT	What must you check here?	
(11) MAIN GATE OUT	What happens when the ID card is swiped?	


Task 3: Know procedures
